## **Placer Community Foundation Awards Placer Community Theater Arts Building Capacity Grant!**

Placer Community Theater's Grant Sub-Committee was thrilled to hear the news that PCT had been awarded a \$1500 grant after all the effort and hard work they'd put into the then unknown endeavour. The process was extremely complex, but committee members, Brenda Lindley, Sally Gardner, Penney Pelkey, Diane Ott, Jackie Crook and Jeri Bliss, felt that they had nothing to lose and only experience to gain. The Placer Community Foundation offers its ABC Grant to arts organizations that provide visual and/or performing arts programs and services to residents along the western slope of Placer County. The award ranges from \$500-\$5,000 and is awarded to improve or increase organizational and management capacity. PCT's Board of Director's elected to accept the award and move forward with the assistance of Angela Tahti, Executive Director of The Arts Council of Placer County. The Arts Council of Placer County is a not-for-profit agency that serves as the catalyst for the arts and humanities in Placer County. The Council encourages excellence and expansion of visual, musical, theatrical, literary, media, and dance art endeavors. Angela recommended and the Board approved consultant Stuart Smith, founder of Motherlode Stage Company in Loomis and current drama program director at Roseville High School, to aide in the development of the scope of work to further advance Placer Community Theater. Stuart recognized immediately that PCT is committed to providing benefits for its members, staying, performing in and giving back to the community they love. Providing support and scholarships to local graduating high school seniors is just one way PCT contributes. There is lots of work to be done. We will keep you posted.
