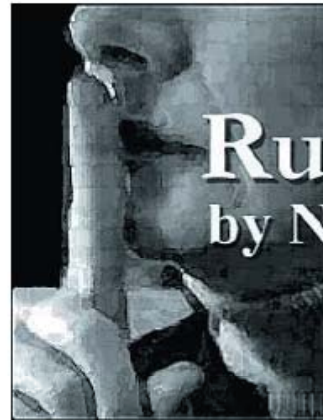

Rhythm 'n Motion is Class Act With PCT

Those of you who attended PCT's production of "Sing On" probably noticed something new the minute you walked into the lobby...members of Rhythm 'n Motion dressed in black and white with teal bow ties and cumber buns doing a wonderful job helping set up, greeting guests, serving deserts and cleaning up for PCT's *Sing On* production. So, who is Rhythm 'n Motion?

Rhythm 'n Motion is a semi professional dance troupe which has grown from one company with thirteen members in 1889, to four companies with twenty five members.

Entrance into Rhythm 'n Motion is by audition only (held in the late summer for the next dance season). Students perform many different styles of dance in the companies including Contemporary, Classical, Lyrical Jazz, Contemporary Ballet, Musical Theater, Hip Hop, Tap, Modern and Musical Theater.

The members of the company have had many opportunities to perform all over California. In addition to national conventions Rhythm 'n Motion's performances have included places such as Disneyland, Paramount's Great America, Six Flags/Marine World Africa, Regional Beauty Pageants and Scholarship programs, grand openings for department stores and malls, local businesses, benefits for schools and churches, children's fairs, and entertainment for local convalescent and retirement homes. The members attend dance conventions and competitions annually and have the opportunity to take classes from international and national choreographers as well as compete with different dances in solos, duets, and group numbers. This April we competed with nine dances at the New York City Dance Alliance Convention. Out of those nine dances, we were awarded 3 gold medals and 6 high silver medals.

On October 29th & 30th, Rhythm 'n Motion is hosting a dance workshop at Pamelot. The renowned FLOW40 will be teaching for the two days right here in Auburn. This December 10th Rhythm 'n Motion will perform at the Roseville Galleria between 3:00-4:00.
